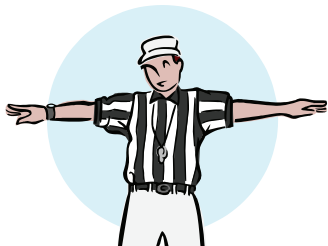

COMMON ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

Unlawful Noise

Unclassified Misdemeanor - Max. Fine \$1000

It is unlawful for any excessive, unnecessary or unusually loud noise or any noise which disturbs, annoys, injures or endangers the comfort, health, peace or safety of persons with ordinary sensibilities within the City.

Disorderly Conduct

Minor Misdemeanor - Max. Fine \$150

No person shall recklessly cause inconvenience, annoyance or alarm to another by doing any of the following: fighting, abusive language, provoking violence, preventing movement of another, and/or engage in offensive behavior. Repeated infractions can escalate this offence to a fourth degree misdemeanor with a max. fine of \$250.

Open Container

Minor Misdemeanor - Max. Fine \$150

No person shall have in the person's possession an opened container of beer or intoxicating liquor while in a State liquor store, any public place, while operating or riding in a motor vehicle or while being in a stationary motor vehicle.

Littering

Third Degree Misdemeanor - Max. Fine \$500

No person shall, regardless of intent, throw, drop, discard, place or deposit litter or solid waste or cause litter or solid waste to be thrown, dropped, discarded, placed or deposited on any public or private property.

First Degree Misdemeanor - Max. Fine \$1000

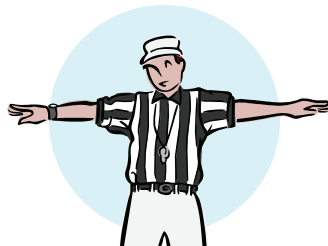

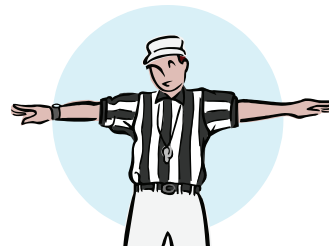

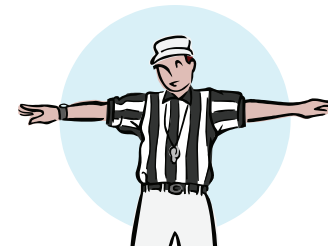
