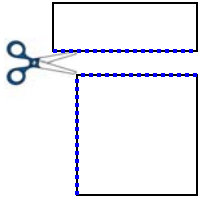
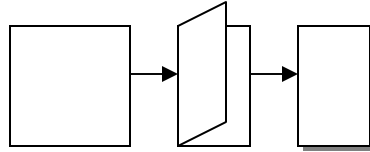


Make Your Own *Friendly* Sidewalk Shoveling Door Hanger

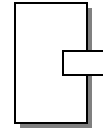
Step 1: Cut along the dotted line to separate the panels.



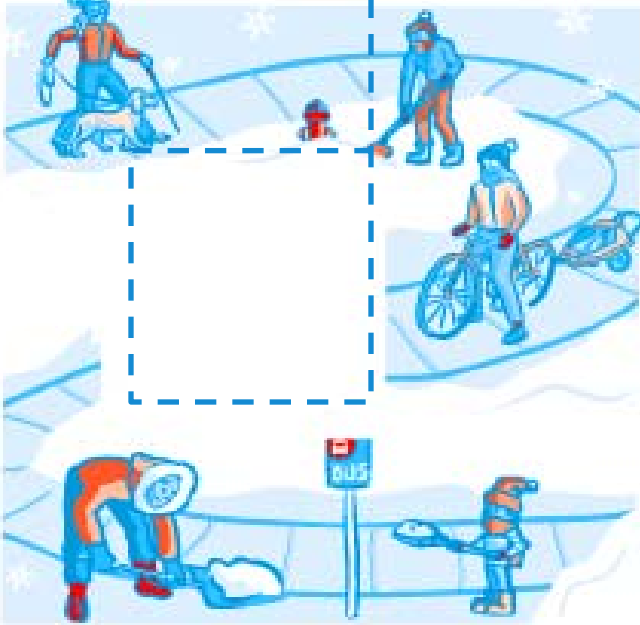
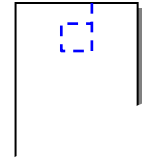
Step 2: Fold square panel in half.



Step 3: Seal long edge with tape or staple.



Step 4: Cut out dotted square.



Who Needs to Shovel?

Owners, renters or business occupants that are adjacent to City sidewalks.

When To Shovel?

For safety, the City recommends snow and ice be cleared from sidewalks 24 hours after snowfall.

Where To Shovel?

Clear the full width of the sidewalk including corners and curb ramps. If possible, salt or sand icy spots. If you can, please help clear around bus stops and fire hydrants.

What If I Don't Shovel?

You may receive a notice from the City and if you still fail to clear your sidewalk you could face a fine.

Need Help?

If you can't shovel there are contractors that will shovel for a fee. If you qualify there are also volunteers that may shovel for you.
